

# Code of Conduct

## Pupils

- Be respectful to your teachers, your fellow students and to yourself.

## Parents/carers

- Be supportive of all our pupils. Do not encourage unhealthy competition, each student is an individual with different goals and objectives and they must be praised on their own personal achievement.
- Enable your child to do their best. Support them with attendance, uniform and encouragement in all of their roles.
- Be realistic in regards to your child's ability and do not set expectations too high – It can be very damaging for children if they feel they are falling short of their parents' expectations.
- Talk to staff respectfully. Ask questions, tell us what is important to you and discuss any concerns that you may have, to help the staff do the best for your child.
- FLTS does publish or post images (static or moving) of students, across some of its online channels. Minimal personal information is published alongside images. It is the Parents responsibility to inform us if you wish your child/children not to appear in any photos etc.
